Event	Format
<b>Youth under 9 Singles</b>	2 GROUPS OF 5 and 2 GROUPS OF 4 Group stages/Quarters/Semis -One game to 15- sudden death at 14-14 top 2 from each group into the semis- decided on head-to-head
<b>Youth ages 10-12 Singles</b>	3 GROUPS OF 5 and 5 GROUPS OF 4 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point Top 2 in each group go through to round of 16- decided on head-to-head if equal points
<b>Youth ages 10-12 Doubles</b>	2 GROUPS OF 5 and 1 GROUP OF 4 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point Top 2 in each group go through plus two best losers- decided on head-to-head if equal within the group- for two best two losers across groups decided net game points difference
<b>Youth Ages 13-15 Singles</b>	9 GROUPS of 4 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point Top 2 in each group go through to round of 16- decided on head-to-head if equal There will be two matches- match 9 and 10 which are added qualifying matches to the round of 16
<b>Youth Ages 13- 15 Doubles</b>	1 GROUP OF 5 and 2 GROUPS OF 4 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point Top 2 in each group go through plus two best losers- decided on head-to-head if equal within the group- for two best two losers across groups decided on net game points difference
<b>Youth Ages 16-18 Singles</b>	1 GROUPS OF 5 and 2 GROUPS OF 4 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point Top 2 in each group go through plus two best losers- decided on head-to-head if equal within the group- for two best two losers across groups decided on net game points difference
<b>Youth Ages 16-18 Doubles</b>	Just 1 Finals match best of 3 games
<b>Adult- Premiership Singles</b>	1 GROUP of 4 and 1 GROUP 3 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point Top 2 in each group go through to semis- decided on head-to-head
<b>Adult- Premiership Doubles</b>	1 GROUP of 4 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point. Top 2 to go through to finals if equal on points- based on head-to-head
<b>Adult- Championship Singles</b>	6 GROUPS of 4 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point. Top 2 in each group go through to round of 16 plus four best losers- decided on head to head if equal within the group- for four best losers across groups decided on net game points difference
<b>Adult- Championship Doubles</b>	2 GROUPS of 3 Best of 3 games to 11. Each game won is 1 point. Top 2 in each group go through to semis- decided on head-to-head if equal within the group.
